Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you have had a lovely Easter holiday as we welcome you back to the last term of the year! The aim of this letter is to outline some of the key aspects of school life in Year 6 which will allow you to support your child both at home and at school.

Our Topics:

Our topics this term are *Let's Reflect* and *New Chapters* as we prepare for secondary school whilst looking back at the pupil's time at All Saints'.

Summer 1 learning is underpinned by **Proverbs 1:5:**

"Let the wise listen and add to their learning and let the discerning get guidance."

In Summer 2, foundation learning is underpinned by 2 Timothy 3:16-17:

16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,

17 so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work

History/Geography: In History, we will be looking at the fascinating Sikh Empire and how its impact on the world today. In Geography, we will be carrying out some field work investigations building on our learning from earlier this year on population.

Art: We will be diving into the world of photography, examining techniques and styles of photo taking.

D.T: At the end of Summer 2 we will be having a 'Come Dine with Me' style topic that will help the students to understand more about Cooking and Nutrition

Science: Our science topic for Summer 1 will be Animals: Circulation and Health. We will be examining the human circulatory system to understand how best to support the human body. In addition, we will be looking at factors that affect this amazing process like exercise and diet. In Summer 2, we will be conducting investigations on the topics we have covered throughout the year such as light, electricity and circuits.

Other learning this term:

English – The children will be developing a variety of reading and writing skills around the text 'Grimm Tales' by Phillip Pullman. This will include writing their own version of the reimagined fairy tale narratives. In Summer 2 we will also be providing the children lots of writing opportunities based on books such as 'The Unforgotten Coat' by Frank Cottrell Boyce.



Maths – We will be working towards our SATs in Summer 1 before taking part in topics and projects based around money, finance and shape.

PSHE- The children will be exploring Growing up, Relationships and Sex Education and transition activities in preparation for secondary school (additional info will be provided on this subject)

PE – Swimming- The children will be taking part in Athletics, Cricket, and Tennis this term. In addition, Year Six will have swimming sessions in Summer 2 (more info to come on this nearer June half term).

RE: We will be covering two different topics in Religious Education this term. We begin with discovering more about Judaism by asking the question, ‘How Does The Torah Help Jewish People To Understand What Being Jewish Means?’ In Summer 2, we will be rounding off our year by thinking about morality within religion and asking the question, ‘What does it mean to live a good life?’

- Maths activity
